


- Thematic S3 Platforms connect regional innovation eco-systems and provide interactive & participatory environment (quadruple helix and bottom-up) supporting interregional cooperation
 - Launched in 2015-2016
 - 208 regions from 33 EU + non EU countries
- Thematic Interregional S3 Partnerships:

Based on their local priorities, EU regions have partnered around areas of common interest and joined forces to:

- avoid duplication,
- exploit complementary strengths across the EU,
- increase critical mass,
- o enhance the development & investments in **EU value chains**,
- build synergies with other regional, national and EU networks and initiatives

• 5 partnerships:


- Consumer Involvement in Agri-Food (4 regions/MS)

- EC DGs involved: AGRI, REGIO, RTD & JRC




















Consumer Involvement in Agri-Food

S3 Thematic Platform on Energy (SP3Energy)



- 6 partnerships in energy + Heating & Cooling initiative
- 89 territorial admin. units in 27 different countries
- Objectives:
 - 1) Support the implementation of the S3 of the regions/countries that have chosen energy-related priorities in their RIS3 (TO1)
 - 2) Assist countries in the optimal uptake of the Cohesion Policy funding opportunities for energy (TO4 & TO7e)
- DGs involved: REGIO, ENER y JRC






S3 Thematic Platform on Industrial Modernisation

- Aims to support EU regions committed to generate a pipeline of industrial investment projects following a bottom-up approach - implemented through interregional cooperation, cluster participation and industry involvement.
- EC DGs involved: REGIO, GROW, RTD and JRC

- Smarter Europe, through innovation, digitisation, economic transformation and support to SMEs
- Greener, carbon free Europe, implementing the Paris Agreement and investing in energy transition, renewables and the fight against climate change
- more Connected Europe, with strategic transport and digital networks
- more Social Europe, delivering on the European Pillar of Social Rights and supporting quality employment, education, skills, social inclusion and equal access to healthcare
- a Europe closer to citizens, by supporting locally-led development strategies and sustainable urban development across the EU.

A larger, stronger and more dynamic and coordinated regional innovation ecosystems

Smart specialisation role in the new paradigm

- Smart specialisation is an essential part of a multi-level governance in EU policy.
- With the emphasis of sustainability as the new EU growth agenda, smart specialisation can connect this top-down directionality with a bottom-up creativity and experimentation
- It introduces place-based innovation-driven policy, which are an intrinsic part of the new larger framework conditions and EU governance system.
- The mission-oriented policy approach is an illustration of this policy approach
