

PANTERA Project's final event

19 June 2023. Brussels, Belgium – PANTERA Project held its final event, highlighting again the project goals, as well as the project achievements. The event took place from 13:00 to 20:00, where the members presented results and discussed outcomes.

54 months passed and the PANTERA project has delivered what has promised:

- Set up a European forum composed of R&I stakeholders active in the fields of smart grids, storage and local energy systems, including policy makers, industrial stakeholders, standardisation bodies and experts in both research and academia, representing the EU energy system (<https://pantera-platform.eu/>). The long-term objective of PANTERA has been formalised in strengthening the EU clean energy R&I activities with special focus on the countries that appear to be less involved.
- These goals, are fulfilled through the launching of an interactive multi-functional collaborative platform EIRIE (<https://ses.jrc.ec.europa.eu/eirie/en>) with the clear mission of: ***“A reference platform and one-stop shop for information sharing, collaboration and knowledge creation aiming at evidently supporting the advancement of R&I activities in Smart Grids at national, regional and pan-European level and, subsequently, facilitating the Energy Transition”.***
